



OACP 2020 Certificate Extension Notice

Due to the unfortunate circumstance regarding the 2020 Pandemic, the OACP has granted all applicants who have completed testing within 2020 an additional 6-months expiry time. The following notice below is only applicable to our applicants who conducted any form of OACP testing in the year of 2020. All applicants who completed and obtained their OACP Certificate within the year of 2020 will be granted an optional 6-month extension added to their expiry date. See below for additional information.

Full OACP Certificate Holders

All applicants who have completed a full OACP Certificate (\$250 testing fee) will be granted an optional 6-month extension to their certificate.

For Example: if your current certificate states "Expiry Date: February 01, 2021", then the certificate will be extended until August 01, 2021.

Equivalency Holders

For applicants who currently possess an OACP Equivalency Certificate, the 6-month extension is only applicable to the testing completed in 2020.

Optional Void

Applicants have the option to void the 6-month extension to their certificate. This means applicants have the option to conduct re-testing 10 months after the issued expiry date.

For example:

If your certificate has an expiry date of July 10, 2021, the earliest re-testing date would be May 10, 2021.

Is this applicable to testing done with ATS before 2019?

The extension is not applicable to ATS issued examinations. If you have a fully expired ATS certificate, then you will be required to obtain a new full OACP Certificate. If you have an OACP equivalency certificate with only the ATS component expired, then you will be required to obtain the Equivalency Testing fee to renew the expired component.
